The children were delighted last week during assembly when the 96.4% attendance was announced and it is clear that the children are committed to trying to improve our whole school attendance. Unfortunately the number of holidays that have already been requested or taken this half term have been significant; 19 children will have been absent for a family holiday during this half term. The impact of term time absences on your child's education is significant and the majority of children struggle to make up for the learning lost whilst absent. We continue to work closely with the Winsford Education Partnership and the Education Welfare Officer to tackle poor attendance and to improve the outcomes for all children.
