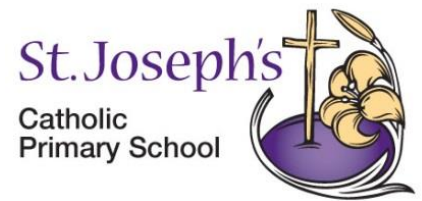


# Homework Policy

## September 2021



### A school overview:-

We believe that to create strong learners it is important to build strong links between home and school. At all times learners will be encouraged to read at home and this may involve learners taking reading books home on a regular basis. We are committed to promoting parental involvement in education and parents will be encouraged to help and support their child in ways that are specific to their age and year group.

### Objectives:-

1. To extend and support the learning process beyond the school day.
2. To embed, reinforce and extend learning of basic skills
3. To use the link between home and school to establish a greater understanding of children's interests relating to each topic
4. To involve learners and their parents in teaching and learning and inspire children to learn beyond the classroom.
5. To extend interest in a wider range of topics.

***We acknowledge that family life can be busy so whilst the ideal is that homework is completed on the set day we understand that this may not be possible. It is therefore expected that all homework is completed by the following Monday morning. Where tasks have not been completed the class teacher will make direct contact with parents/carers to discuss.***

KS1	Monday	Maths task set on Teams using TT Rockstars or MyMaths
	Tuesday	Reading to an adult – recorded in school planner by adult
	Wednesday	10 Spelling Shed
	Thursday	Reading to an adult – recorded in school planner by adult
	Friday	Phonics activity set on Teams Reading to an adult – recorded in school planner by adult
	Home learning should take no longer than 30 minutes	
KS2	Monday	10 TT Rockstars Reading (to an adult if on the reading scheme) – recorded in school planner by adult
	Tuesday	Spelling Shed
	Wednesday	MyMaths or Century Maths Nugget
	Thursday	Century English Nugget
	Friday	Teams activity Reading (to an adult if on the reading scheme) – recorded in school planner by adult
	Home learning should take no more than 40 minutes	
<b><i>Additional 'Family' projects may be set around special occasions and events. Full details will be sent home at the relevant time via Teams, Class Dojo or the school planner.</i></b>
