Dear Parents/ Carers,

Firstly, thank you for all your support with ensuring the children are well equipped for their Learning Outside the Classroom sessions. As the weather becomes increasingly cold and challenging it is vital that the children have multiple layers on and wherever possible a waterproof outer layer. If the children are suitable dressed there are very few weather conditions that are unsuitable for the children to continue their learning outside. It is also a good idea for the children to have spare clothes if the forecast is particularly wet.

As we begin the new year we are going to change how we provide LOtC sessions on a Friday. This will now be used with small groups of children to focus on a skill. The same group of children will take part each Friday morning for six weeks, you will receive a separate letter if your children will be involved in these sessions.
