

Homework Policy

A school overview:-

We believe that to create strong learners it is important to build strong links between home and school. At all times learners will be encouraged to read at home and this may involve learners taking reading books home on a regular basis. We are committed to promoting parental involvement in education and parents will be encouraged to help and support their child in ways that are specific to their age and year group.

Objectives:-

1. To extend and support the learning process beyond the school day.
2. To embed, reinforce and extend learning of basic skills
3. To use the link between home and school to establish a greater understanding of children's interests relating to each topic
4. To involve learners and their parents in teaching and learning and inspire children to learn beyond the classroom.
5. To extend interest in a wider range of topics.

We acknowledge that family life can be busy however in preparation for secondary education we expect that homework is completed on the set day. All homework will be set on a Monday morning. Where tasks have not been completed the class teacher will make direct contact with parents/carers to discuss. All homework is set via Teams for KS1 and KS2. Homework is set via Class Dojo for EYFS.

	Friday	Maths task set on Teams using My Maths Reading to an adult – recorded on Go Read by adult
	Home learning should take no longer than 30 minutes	
KS2	Monday	Maths task set on Teams – 10 TT Rockstars Reading (to an adult if on the reading scheme) – recorded on Go Read by an adult
	Tuesday	10 Spelling Shed set on Teams
	Wednesday	MyMaths or Century Maths Nugget set on Teams
	Thursday	Century Grammar Nugget set on Teams
	Friday	Century Reading Nugget set on Teams Reading (to an adult if on the reading scheme) – recorded on Go Read by an adult
	Home learning should take no more than 40 minutes	
	Accelerated Reader 20 minutes of reading each day and quizzes completed as appropriate. (NB: Additional reading can be recorded on Go Read by children, reading must be recorded by an adult twice a week)

This policy will ensure that a sensible approach is taken by all and that learners will benefit through the co-operation of home and school by extending learning beyond the school day. Home learning is there to be enjoyed and not to cause worry or stress to learners or parents.
